<u>RULES</u>: USPC Rules for Dressage Rallies 2024, USPC Horse Management Handbook 2024, USPC Dressage Annual Newsletter 2024, USPC Western Dressage Rulebook 2024, USPC Western Dressage Newsletter 2024

**TEAMS:** Consist of 3 or 4 riders and a Stable Manager, No charge for Stable Manager, AND they will receive a special award for coming! Teams may be mixed levels of members, including ages, and certification. May include adult pony club members on the team with permission of parents of all under 18 competitors on team. Individual riders welcome and will be put on scratch teams. Competitors may compete in the Standard or Modified division (a little more of a schooling opportunity). Each team **must** supply two adult volunteers. Each team must have a chaperone (may be one of the volunteers), at least 21 years old, and may have a coach. The chaperone may not be a coach, but a volunteer may be a coach. Per Dressage rulebook, coaches must be willing to coach any pony clubber who asks for help.

**STABLING:** This are only 16 stalls, open pipe stall mare motel. The organizer will take under consideration who will use a stall based on which horses will tie to a trailer, and which horses traveled with each other or from the same barn for biosecurity purposes. Competitors should arrive at 6:00 am Saturday October 19 The rally begins with briefing at 6:45 am. Bring your own shavings and feed.

<u>DIRECTIONS & PARKING:</u> Follow the pony club event signs and the attached map as well. Santa Rosa Ranchos is 23550 Rose Quartz dr Perris CA 92570

**FOOD:** Bring your own lunch and water. No lunch will be provided. Please plan accordingly.

<u>CHAPERONES</u>: The team chaperone must be on site at all times. Chaperones will also be given a volunteer job to do, as they do not follow the team during the event. They are just on call. <u>No parent will be allowed in the barn for any reason.</u>

**VOLUNTEERS:** We need you! Each team must send two volunteers.

<u>TESTS:</u> Intro-4<sup>th</sup> Level USDF and WDAA intro- Level 5 This is a non-qualifying Dressage rally <u>TURNOUT:</u> Dress for all competitors must adhere to the Article 36, pages 10-11 of Pony Club Dressage Rulebook 2024 <u>DIVISIONS</u>: <u>Ages are as of January 1, 2024</u>

#### DRESSAGE or Western Dressage

Jr All Levels 10-17 Sr All Levels 18+

Article 36- Competitor Attire Each participant is responsible for organizing their own attire and equipment which must meet all safety requirements outlined in Article 15. Competitors should be neat and clean with inappropriate jewelry not permitted; see Horse Management Handbook for specifications. Participants must wear a medical armband or bracelet as specified in Article 15.3. A Pony Club pin must be worn at all times unless otherwise stated by rally officials. Felt can be placed behind pins using the below designations: Certification Felt Color A: .Royal Blue, H-A Orange, B Red, H-HM/ Purple. H Brown, C- White, C+ Pink, C-1 and C-2 Green, D-1 through D-Yellow.

- <u>1. General Barn Attire</u>—Long pants, mid-length or longer shorts or modest length skirts made of khaki, chino or denim materials of any color, with no rips or tears, a shirt with sleeves, and appropriate unmounted footwear (Article 15.4), are examples of appropriate attire for unmounted work in the barn.
- <u>2. Horse Inspection (Jog Outs)</u>—Attire must be safe, appropriate, neat and clean. It must include a helmet (meeting USPC Helmet Policy, Article 15.1), and appropriate un -mounted footwear (Article 15.4). Workmanlike and discipline appropriate attire including a tucked in collared shirt with pants/skirt/midlength shorts/riding pants. If the pants/skirt has belt loops a belt is required. Blue jeans are not acceptable for English discipline horse inspection attire.
- **3.** Turnout Inspection and first round of competition—All competitors must turnout and compete in appropriate competition attire.
- 4. Competition Attire for Dressage: Required Helmet—Black or any conservative color meeting USPC Helmet Policy (Article 15.1). Shirt—Shirt of any color with a collar and sleeves, tucked into pants. Hair—Hair should be neatly secured and away from the eyes. Neckwear—Stock tie, choker, tie or integrated stand-up collar. Traditional stock ties require a stock pin, pre-tied stock ties may be worn with or without stock pin. Coat/Jackets/Vest—Short riding coat of solid conservative color. A cutaway coat (modified tailcoat) with short tail is permitted. Competitors may compete without a jacket. In such cases, the shirt must be neatly tucked into the riding breeches. Pants—Jodhpur or breeches. White or light color. Belt—If pants have belt loops, belts are required. Footwear—Conventional type of riding footwear with a heel that covers the ankles are required. Through First Level, tall black or brown dress or field boots, or jodhpur/paddock boots with matching full grain smooth leather leg piece or leather-like material are allowed.

- Anyone experiencing flu like symptoms, please stay home.
- Each horse must have a 3 days temperature log which is attached
- **Enforcement Authority** The rally organizer, rally organizing committee, and officials have the authority to remove from the facility any person who does not comply with the regulations and requirements in effect at the competition.
